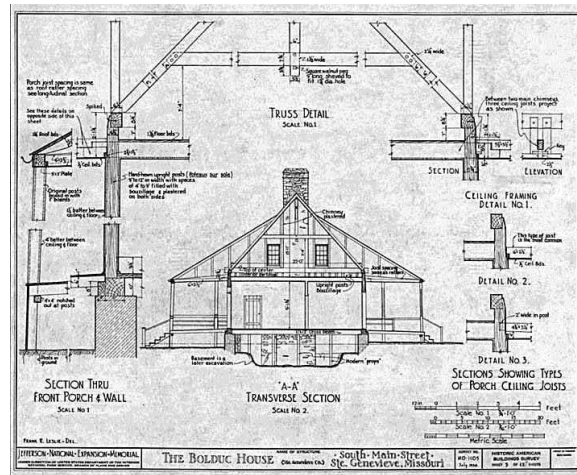

Abstract

Historical Note

The Historic Preservation Program is offered by Southeast Missouri State University's Department of History for students who want to pursue careers in preservation of the built environment, historic site administration, archives, or museum management. The curriculum combines classroom learning with hands-on practice and field experience in history, research methods, architectural history, preservation, historic site administration, museum studies, and archival studies. Students complete internships with museums, sites, and historical agencies around the nation.

Scope and Content

Research papers and other documents created by students in Historic Preservation courses. These papers and reports are either individual projects or group projects mostly dealing with the history of individual people, properties, and regions of Cape Girardeau and Southeast Missouri. These include several National Register of Historic Places nominations. Projects are arranged by subject matter, then chronologically by date of project. The HP100 Oral History interviews are arranged by year, then alphabetically.

Archivist Note: Appendix 1 and 2 are arranged by project location, then media location. The following abbreviations are used within the container list of this finding aid: This is an open collection with additions made periodically.

[AP] -- There are accompanying photographs located in Series VII, Box 4256-4258

[NP] -- There are slides or negatives located in Box 1001.

[OS] -- There are over-sized items located

[R] -- Restricted: Items involving oral history interviews that do not have release forms and therefore may not be published, quoted or copied.

Series Descriptions

Series I: African American Studies

Contains projects on various African American topics, including slavery, the lynching of Cleo Wright in Sikeston, MO in 1942 and the John S. Cobb Elementary School, an African American school in Cape Girardeau, MO built in 1916. For more information on Cobb School see Series IX: Subseries 1, which contains an oral history project on the school.

Series II: Architecture

Projects involving the local architecture of the greater Cape Girardeau area. This series is arranged by subject and then sorted chronologically.

Subseries 1: Businesses

Materials concerning Cape City Bottling Works (Thilenus Warehouse), 228 N. Pacific, Cape Girardeau.

Subseries 2: Homes

Structural reports and surveys dealing with personal residences in the Cape Girardeau area, including homes of individuals, such as Rush H. Limbaugh, B.G. Shackelford, and the D. A. Glenn House. Also includes a study on early German vernacular cottages.

Subseries 3: Hunter Log Home

News Clippings, Correspondence, structural reports, and drawings of the 18th Century Hunter Log Home. Also included is a conceptual plan for the Hunter Heritage Education Farm. There is an additional oral history interview in Box 3230 Folders 011-012.

Subseries 4: National Register Nominations

The National Register of Historic Places (National Register) is the U. S. Government's list of districts, buildings, structures, objects, and sites that are deemed worthy of preservation. This subseries includes nominations for Fort D Civil War site, the Oliver House, the Colonel George C. Thilenius home, and the historic district nomination for Southeast Missouri State Normal School #3.

Subseries 5: Surveys

Architectural surveys that encompass cross-sections of Cape Girardeau, MO and Jackson, MO. These include a street-by-street, building-by-building listing; includes descriptions and printed pictures.

Series III: Cemeteries

Projects that include plot listings and remediation methods for Old Lorimier Cemetery in Cape Girardeau, MO and Old McKendree Cemetery in Jackson, MO.

Series IV: Cultural and Heritage

Various reports involving cultural events of the area, including Franklin D. Roosevelt's visit to Cape Girardeau, the Old Field Bog, The Cape – Jackson Interurban Railway Co., and the Great Depression.

Series V: Districts and Cities

Reports on regions of southeast Missouri that include the Haarig District of Cape Girardeau, Mine La Motte, Poplar Bluff, and Cape Girardeau commerce.

Series VI: Individuals and Families

Reports on prominent individuals from the Cape Girardeau and Ste. Genevieve regions, as well as family histories, including, Thad Snow, Robert McClure, Lucille Basler, and Elibeth Jacob.

Series VII: Southeast Missouri State University

Includes reports on various aspects of preservation within the university, including the rehab of the Social Science Building (Carnahan Hall).

Series VIII: Photographic Materials

Includes photographic projects done by students and photos that accompany projects previously listed. Arranged by subject, then chronologically. Appendix 1 contains a cross-reference guide of the photographs, negatives, slides, and projects. Also included are photos taken by former student Brian Driscoll.
