### Historical Note

The Missouri Committee for the Humanities awarded Professor White, Dr. Christabel Lacy, and Mark Taylor a grant to fund a project to research rural schools. Bob White was a professor and historian at Southeast Missouri State University, Dr. Lacy was an anthropology professor at Southeast Missouri State University, and Mark Taylor was a graduate assistant in the department of history. The grant project's goal was to determine the social, economic, educational, and cultural impact that rural schools had on the lives of those who worked at and attended these institutions. The end result of the grant was a published book, Rural Schools and Their Communities in Cape Girardeau County, a traveling exhibit, and a slide presentation..

### Scope and Content Note

Materials pertaining to a grant awarded to Professor White, Dr. Lacy, and Mark Taylor by the Missouri Committee for the Humanities. Records include paperwork for the grant, microfilm reels of county government documents dating from the early 1900s, a sound reel and a slide presentation, photographs of early Cape Girardeau, images of rural schools, (photographs, negatives, and glass plate negatives), and cassette tapes of the oral history interviews.

Some of the photographic materials do not directly relate to the Rural Schools project, but were also collected by Professor White over the course of his career at Southeast Missouri State University.

The collection is arranged by the format and subject of the materials. Series I deals with the grant process, and Series II-V contain the research and records collected and created over the course of the project.

## Series Descriptions

### **Series I: Grant Records**

Contains the paperwork on the Missouri Committee for the Humanities grant, including the application, financial records, and other records necessary for the completion of the project.

### **Series II: Oral History Interviews**

Cassette tapes of interviews conducted with students and teachers of the rural schools.

### **Series III: "Rural Schools and their Communities" Program**

Sound reel, cassettes, and slides for the presentation, "Rural Schools & Their Communities."

### **Series IV: Photographic Materials**

Various images of Southeast Missouri, arranged by subject and by type.

#### **Subseries 1: Early Cape Girardeau**

Includes images of Southeast Missouri State University buildings, the Mississippi River, buildings, people, transportation, and panoramas of early Cape Girardeau. Photographs are arranged by date, undated photographs are arranged alphabetically by title.

#### **Subseries 2: Ste. Genevieve Bi-Centennial Parade**

Images of floats in the parade that took place in 1935. Arranged alphabetically.

#### **Subseries 3: Rural Schools**

Images of the rural schools in Southeast Missouri, as they were when they were in use, and as they looked in 1985. Arranged alphabetically.

#### **Subseries 4: Negatives**

Negatives of images taken of the rural schools. Arranged alphabetically.

#### **Subseries 5: Glass plate negatives**

Glass plate negatives of images of unidentified people and places.

Microfilm copies of Cape Girardeau County tax books and land assessments and Cape Girardeau school tax books.

Maps, blueprints, photographs, and newspapers from the southeast Missouri Region.
