She has published several articles, and her book, The Other Asian America: Limeña Writers of Asian Descent, is due to be published in 2008.

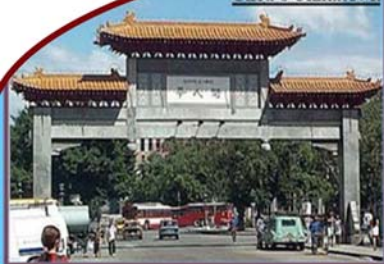
